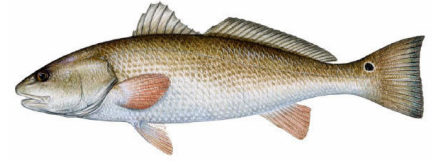


Tournament Rules



- A. ***New Change*** The Fishing area will be from the Bull Pen to the VA line (or in an area designated by the **National Park Service**.)
- B. Official entry form must be presented when submitting a fish to a tournament official.
- C. Fish must be measured and verified by on-duty tournament official to qualify for entry.
- D. All fish caught on Friday must be registered before 11:59 PM Friday night, and all fish caught on Saturday must be registered before 11:59 PM Saturday night and all fish caught on Sunday must be registered before 3 PM Sunday. Any fish caught after 3 PM on Sunday will not be counted.
- E. The tournament, or any portion thereof, may be canceled by the tournament director or by Harbor Tackle if circumstances, such as bad weather arise. If the tournament is canceled before start time all fees will be refunded.
- F. Identifying tags and/or buttons will be issued for each contestant. Contestants, while fishing, must have this identification with them at all times. This identification must accompany the contestant participating in the tournament activities.
- G. All fishing will be governed by IGFA State and Federal Rules and Regulations.
- H. The Tournament Director and Judge reserve the right to disqualify any fish of suspicious nature that is entered.
- I. All anglers will display their fishing gear for examination to any tournament official upon request.
- J. CB or cellular phone (channel and phone number to be announced at the tournament) will be used for tournament communications and emergencies.
- K. Anglers will need a CB or cellular phone in their vehicle.
- L. Contestants may not use a net or gaff. No use of boats or any other flotation devices may be used for placing baits. No assistance is allowed in casting or landing of fish.
- M. Any fish killed in the tournament becomes the property of the tournament.
- N. Surf fishing only, no bay side. Fishing only on designated beach area.
- O. All measurements will be determined by TAIL LENGTH. In case of a tie, the first fish measured wins.
- P. All vehicles must have a valid ORV permit along with the proper safety equipment required by The National Park Service.
- Q. All participants must be actively engaged in fishing while on the beach. No overnight camping is allowed except in designated areas.
- R. All anglers must be respectful of everyone on the beach.
- S. No fish will be scored if caught in VA waters.
- T. The National Park Service will not be held liable for anything regarding or during this tournament.
- U. **All Red Drum** must be released alive.
